HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE:

In the months of April and May, use this calendar to plan family activities, engage in dinner conversations, and train your minds to be more aware of the needs of those around you. Whether it is becoming more aware of the needs of siblings, family members, neighbors, schoolmates, or the homeless person on the corner, **awareness and action** is the goal. Remember there is adventure in loving others.

STEPS:

- **1. Register your family to participate.** We want to be able to encourage your family and pray for you as we journey together.
- **2. Keep track of your points.** Each day is worth 10 points. Some days only require a conversation, while other days require more investment of time and resources. The maximum number of points possible is 620 points.
- **3. Complete the family evaluation link at the end of May.** Be sure to include your total number of points earned. The family evaluation link will be sent via e-mail to every family that has registered.
- **4. Receive your prize pack (if in top five).** Five families with the most points will receive an *Adventure Awaits* Summer Prize Pack at our Family Experience summer kickoff on June 3.


