How to Use this Journal

20 DAYS OF PRAYER TOPICS

Twenty Days of Prayer is a family prayer journal designed to help you slow down and dedicate time to reading the scripture and praying together with your family. The days can be done in as short as five minutes or extend longer depending on your schedule. They also do not have to be done 20 days in a row. The intent is to see God move in your family through prayer. We encourage you to take notes, write prayers and requests, and reflect back from time to time. Enjoy the journey together as a family.

scripture

Read the scripture chosen for each prayer topic together as a family, or individually depending on your family schedule

reflect

Take a few minutes and reflect on the verse and the prayer topic. Talk about the verse and its context in your family. Write a few notes on how this applies to your family and community.

pray

Pray together as a family using the reflections from the verse and discussion. Make note of the prayers to see how God answers prayers in your 20 days together
